It will be a Good Strategy to send a team of staff to attend this program, so the team will have a common understanding of what needs to be done to implement Good and Best Practices in the Gas Plants. The team members may attend different durations depending on their expected level of involvement in the Gas Plant Operation, Maintenance or Improvement. Engineering, Process Improvement and Research & Development staff can also attend with the team so they can provide the necessary Support to the Implementation Efforts of the participants.

Implementation Teams: This program can be used to train implementation teams...

1. when a new project or initiative is being started in your organization
2. when a new strategic focus is being initiated
3. just prior to a consultant being hired to advise the organization
